What is MyZonePilot?

MyZonePilot is an early stage project exploring ways to help delivery drivers better understand where and when work is happening in their city.

Many drivers rely on guesswork when deciding where to drive, when to move zones, or whether a busy area will actually stay busy.

MyZonePilot is being built around a simple idea: drivers should have better visibility into real activity patterns across their city.

Why This Matters

- Which zones are actually worth driving to?
- Is the busy area really busy or already saturated?
- When should I move to another part of the city?
- Are there patterns to when demand builds in certain areas?
- Most platforms keep this information hidden.

What MyZonePilot Is Exploring

- City activity awareness for drivers
- Insights based on real driver movement patterns
- Visibility into potential work zones across the city
- Helping drivers make more informed decisions about where to drive

Why Early Drivers Matter

MyZonePilot is currently in its early development phase. The direction of the platform is still being shaped through feedback from delivery drivers.

- Which tools get built
- Which problems get solved first
- What actually helps drivers on the road

Joining the Early Driver List

Joining the early driver list is completely free. It simply allows drivers to follow the project, receive updates, participate in early testing, and help shape the direction of the platform.

The MyZonePilot Driver Promise

MyZonePilot is being built around one principle: drivers come first.

The goal is not to benefit delivery platforms or take advantage of drivers. The goal is to explore tools that help drivers better understand their city and make more informed decisions about where and when to work.
